Your research article has been accepted for publication in International Journal of Poultry Science. However it is observed that References are not cited in the text according to the new format of the journal.

First of all, in REFERENCES section, assign the number from 1 to onward to each reference. References must be cited in the text in superscript digits at the end of sentence or paragraph before punctuation or full stop¹. In case of two or more references, separate the superscript digits by comma^{1,2,6}. Moreover, If there are more references but in continuous numbers then use dash between superscript digits²⁻⁶. Citation may be direct or indirect, see the following examples;

Direct citation

- a) Farooq *et al.*¹ studied the temperature effect on cuticular hydrocarbons of termite.
- b) According to Shafqat and Saba², cuticular hydrocarbons can be used to identify termite species.
- c) Variations in cuticular hydrocarbons may also assist for species recognition and foraging behaviour, investigated by Zeeshan and Pasha³.

Indirect citation

- a) Temperature affects cuticular hydrocarbons of termite¹. Cuticular hydrocarbons can be used to identify termite species². Variations in cuticular hydrocarbons may also assist for species recognition and foraging behavior³.

Results, the main findings;

Conclusions, brief summary and potential implications.

Main conclusions and interpretation of findings with emphasis on new important aspects of the study and observations should be included in the abstract.

Statement on Conflicts of Interest

A statement on conflicts of interest should be included in the manuscript. Either mention: 'none declared', or specify the authors' financial or other interests which should be known to the readers. The Journal policy requires that authors of manuscripts should reveal any financial interests or connections that may be of direct or indirect nature. one should also clarify other situations that might arise the question of bias in the reported work , conclusions, implications, stated opinions including pertinent commercial and other sources of funding for the individual author(s) ,for the associated department(s), organization(s), personal relationships and direct academic competition.
